Kathryn Castelloes began working with the N.C. Department of Labor in 1994 in the Pre-Apprenticeship Division. After working there for four years, she became an apprenticeship consultant with the Apprenticeship and Training Bureau. In 2006, she began working as the western field supervisor and in 2008 started as the bureau chief for Apprenticeship and Training. In 2014, the Apprenticeship and Training Bureau was transferred to the Department of Commerce and in 2017 Apprenticeship was transferred to the N.C. Community College System, where she serves as director of ApprenticeshipNC.

She believes in the long-term benefit of partnerships with community organizations and school systems to solve industry issues of worker shortages and the skills gap.

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
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Vice President of Economic Development N.C. Community College System
